### EVENT

The Buffalo Chip TT presented by Indian Motorcycle will play host to Round 12 of the American Flat Track season featuring the AFT Singles and AFT Twins classes.

### REGISTRATION

10:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. Current, renewing and New Members.

All 2018 American Flat Track events are **Pre-Entry ONLY**. Entries closed August 3<sup>rd</sup>. No post entry will be available at the event.

### PADDOCK TRANSPORTER PARKING:

Early Load-In will be available from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Saturday August 4th. Pit Gates open again 8:00 a.m. Sunday the 5th. Pits will be assigned.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE AFT PIT AREA

- Exit **US 90** onto Pleasant Valley Road (east)
- Turn left (North) onto **Fort Mead Way**
- Pass the front entrance of the Buffalo chip, Turn right (east) onto **Alkali Road**.
- Turn right (south) onto **132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**. Look for the white AFT tractor trailer on the left. The pit entrance (and Registration) will be located just past the AFT truck

**FUEL, NOTE: individual pails will not be available. Fuel will be pumped into your container. Bring your 112 Supreme pail or new jug**  
The official fuel of American Flat Track is Sunoco Supreme 112. If you did not pre-order race fuel on your event entry form, there will NOT be any additional fuel for sale at the event. **If you did pre-order fuel for both the Buffalo Chip and the Black Hills Half Mile, Fuel will be distributed the following way:**

- Individual pails are not available for distribution
- Teams that pre-ordered fuel must bring their own container to tech and their purchased fuel will be pumped into their container
- NOTE: bring container that has had 112 Supreme in it previously or a new container. Do not risk contaminating your fuel by having non-compliant residual fuel in your container.
- GET YOUR FUEL EARLY. The pumping process will take a little more time to do it safely and accurately

### SCORING TRANSPONDERS

Entered riders will be issued a rechargeable transponder during technical inspection for use during the event. Riders will be responsible for the loss or damage to transponders, unless the loss or damage is the result of a verified on-track crash during official practice, qualifying or race at the event. Transponders must be returned to Tech Inspection as soon as possible at the end of the event or riders will be charged a replacement fee as outlined in the 2018 American Flat Track rulebook.

### TIRE REGULATIONS

Competitors seeking tires are encouraged to call Steve Brubaker with Race Tire Service at (800) 772-8473. Competitors may only use the specific Dunlop tires for the Buffalo Chip TT:

Front tire for both AFT Twins and Singles:  
Dunlop DT3 130/80-19 compound F5

Rear tire for AFT Singles at the Buffalo TT:  
Dunlop DT3 140/80-19 compound R5 (**Mandatory in all sessions**)

Rear tires eligible for AFT Twins at the Buffalo Chip TT:  
Dunlop DT3 140/80-19 compound R5  
Dunlop DT3 140/80-19 compound R8

### MACHINE SOUND REQUIREMENTS, SOUND TESTING

Per AFT General Equipment Standards and Competitor Bulletin #2017-05, all machines must pass sound test utilizing SAEJ1287 procedure. Detailed testing procedures can be found in the appendices of the 2018 Rulebook and Comp Bulletin #2017-05. Pre-event testing can be available Saturday August 4th. ### RIDER AND CREW CHIEF BRIEFINGS

All riders must attend the pre-race briefings as published on the schedule. Attendance is mandatory.

### RIDER AUTOGRAPH SESSION

Unless otherwise announced, there will be an open pit area rider autograph session at the Buffalo Chip from 4:30 p.m. – 5:15 p.m. All AFT teams and riders are required to participate. Riders are to be fan accessible and must wear their team shirts or leathers/racing attire. Participation in the rider autograph session is mandatory.
